William Newhauser Dies In 70th Year

Services for William E. Newhauser of 205 East Moore Street, Hackettstown, will be held at 2 o'clock this (Thursday) afternoon at the Cochran Funeral Home with the Rev. Frank T. Reed, pastor of Trinity Methodist Church, officiating. Burial will be in Hackettstown Union Cemetery.

Mr. Newhauser, 69, died of a heart attack at his home Sunday, January 5, 1958.

Born March 6, 1888, in Lebanon Pa., Mr. Newhauser had resided in Hackettstown for about 50 years.

He was cited last August for his faithful service and contribution to the Lackawanna Leather Company upon his retirement after 50 years service with the local firm. He joined the leather firm as a young man when the company was only four years old. His entire career was spent in the tanning and finishing departments.

Surviving are his wife, the former Bertha Blackburn, and two grandchildren. He was born at Lebanon, Pa., and died at Hackettstown, Pa., on Sunday, January 5, 1958.
