

## Joint services scheduled for grandson, grandmother

EASTON, Pa. — Joint services will be held today for Susan C. Nicholas, 66, of New Village, and her grandson, Andrew Savoia, 16, of Oxford.

Young Savoia died Monday at Sacred Heart Hospital Center, Allentown Pa., where he was admitted Saturday after being injured when he reportedly jumped from a car in White Township Friday.

Mrs. Nicholas died Sunday in Easton Hospital.

According to state police, young Savoia was the passenger in a car driven by Glen Gross, 18, of Oxford. He allegedly jumped from the car while traveling along Apple Mountain Road.

Mrs. Nicholas was born in Phillipsburg. She is survived by her husband, Thomas E.; two sons, Charles Platia of Alpha and Estaban Platia of Phillipsburg, two daughters, Mrs. Kathleen Savoia of

Oxford and Mrs. Dawn Taylor of Charlesville, Va.; four sisters, Mrs. Mary Shumock of Somerville, Mrs. Catherine Shelley of Pearl River, N.Y., Mrs. Elizabeth Gyurkovics of Phillipsburg and Mrs. Paula Troiani of Massapequa N.Y.; two brothers, Joseph Dudish of Phillipsburg and Andrew Dudish of Easton, Pa. and 10 grandchildren.
