

FRANK DAVIS NUNN

Funeral services were held Sunday for Frank Davis Nunn, 59, of 413 Lafayette St., who died Thursday at Hackettstown Community Hospital where he was admitted early that morning.

Born Sept. 11, 1915 in Mansfield Township, he was a son of Jacob and Anna Helmes Nunn. He was a 1934 graduate of Hackettstown High School where he played varsity football for three years.

He retired in 1973 from Picatinny Arsenal, Dover, where he had been a mechanical engineering technician for 34 years.

He was a veteran of World War II, serving with the 82nd Ordinance battalion, Fifth Army, in the African, Sicilian and Italian campaigns.

He was a member of the Rockport Presbyterian Church, where he was Sunday School superintendent and a member of the board of elders. He belonged to Independence Lodge 42 F&AM, Hackettstown, and the Heart of Warren Chapter of Deborah Hospital.

He is survived by his widow, the former Margaret Snyder; a sister, Mrs. Dora Wydner of Hackettstown R.D., and two brothers, Lyman and Alfred, both of Hackettstown.

Funeral services were conducted by the Rev. Jerome Gould of the Rockport Presbyterian Church in the Cochran Funeral Home, Hackettstown.

Interment was in Pequest Union Cemetery.
