

**MRS. ALFRED NUNN**

Services were conducted Monday afternoon at Gethsemane Lutheran Church in Hackettstown for Mrs. Virginia Blackwood Nunn, 40, of 502 Fourth Street, Hackettstown, who died last Thursday, November 2, 1972, at Morristown Memorial Hospital following a long illness.

The Rev. Thomas P. Armour, pastor of Gethsemane Church, officiated, assisted by the Rev. Lawrence Reed of Hazelton, Pa. Interment followed in Pequest Union Cemetery, Great Meadows. Arrangements were handled by the Cochran Funeral Home of Hackettstown.

Born October 22, 1932, in Morristown, Mrs. Nunn was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Stanley J. Blackwood of 409 Lafayette Street, Hackettstown. She was graduated from Hackettstown High School in 1950 as class valedictorian and earned a bachelor's degree in elementary education in 1954 from Newark State College. She taught for two years in the Dover school system.

In recent years, Mrs. Nunn

was a regular substitute teacher in the Hackettstown public school system. She was a member of Gethsemane Lutheran Church, where she was vice president of the Women's Guild. She was past chairman of Friendship Circle and a member of the Altar Guild.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Nunn is survived by her husband, Alfred; a son, Gregory, and a daughter, Miss Jacqueline Nunn, both at home, and two sisters, Mrs. Sylvia Hansler of Hackettstown and Mrs. Judith Pool of Great Meadows.
