## **Cornelius J. "Neil" O'Neill, Jr.**

Cornelius J. "Neil" O'Neill, Jr., 75, of Hackettstown, died on May 18 at home.

He was born and grew up in Bayonne, and later lived in Austin, Tx, where he was stationed with the Army Air Corp. He moved to Hackettstown in 1945.

He was a community relations manager, having worked for New Jersey Bell Telephone Co. until retiring in 1981 after 33 years.

He was a second lieutenant of the Army Air Corp from 1942 to 1945 and was a navigational in-

structor in San Marcos, Tx.

He graduated from St. Peter's College in 1940, was a member of St. Mary's Church of the Assumption, was one of the original founders and site donors of Hackettstown Community Hospital, was the first P.T.A. president of St. Mary's School, was active in United Way of Morris, was a member of the Chamber of Commerce in Booton, the Voluntary Action Center of Morris, the Hackettstown Rotary Club, and the Telephone Pioneers.

He is survived by his wife, Jane P., at home; sons Cornelius J. "Tex" III of Charlotte, N.C., Kevin M. of Hackettstown, and James P. of Summit; daughters Jane M. O'Neill, of Edgewater, Md., Regina K. Judge, Independence Township and Eileen H. Carson of Derwood, Md; and eight grandchildren.

A Mass of Christian Burial was said at St. Mary's Church of the

Assumption in Hackettstown.
