Steve S. Orlouski

BRADENTON, FLA. — Services were held Feb. 28 for Steve S. Orlouski, 51, of Bradenton, Fla., who died Feb. 16 at the Manatee Memorial Hospital, Bradenton.

He was born Feb. 16, 1941, in Passaic to Steve and Martha Figula Orlouski of Bradenton. He moved to Bradenton from Hackettstown two years ago.

He was a salesman at Ray West Marketing, Bradenton. Prior to that he owned Stacy Lynn Construction in Hackettstown.
