Funeral services were held for former Hackettstown resident Charles G. Ott, 56, of 30 Cambridge Drive, who died May 31 at St. Vincent's Hospital in Montclair.

Born in Bloomfield, he previously lived in Hackettstown and West Caldwell before moving to North Caldwell.
