

OBITUARY

PATRICIA JEAN PALMER

elder daughter of Councilman and Mrs. Whitney W. Palmer, died suddenly last Thursday evening, January 4, 1945, at her home, 209 Moore Street, Hackettstown. Complaining of illness while in Easton with her mother that afternoon, Miss Palmer retired, when she reached home, and medical aid was summoned. She expired a few hours later of acute pneumonia and complications.

Born at Orange on October 5, 1925, she was a daughter of Whitney W. and Jean Gutherson Palmer. Beside her parents she leaves a sister, Miss Carolyn Palmer, a senior at Hackettstown High School.

Miss Palmer was graduated in 1943 from Hackettstown High School, where she was head cheerleader, participated in archery and basketball, was a member of the Glee Club and served on class committees. At the time of her death she was a senior at Centenary Junior College, where she was a member of Delta Sigma sorority, the College Chorus, the Book Club, and where she had qualified as a Senior Life Saver in swimming. In the community she was a member of the Presbyterian Choir.

The funeral was held Saturday afternoon at the Cochran Funeral Home, conducted by the Rev. Alvin A. Jones of Trinity Methodist Church. Burial was in the Washington Cemetery.
