

Death of Anthony Palminteri.

Anthony Palminteri, who until about six years ago conducted for seven or eight years a shoe repair shop in the building now the office of the Hackettstown Electric Light Company, died on March 17 at his home in Farmingdale, L. I., of heart trouble. He was the father of Mrs. Joseph Feneche of Sharp street. Other children surviving by a first marriage are the Misses Frances and Carmella Palminteri now in Italy. Their mother died while the family resided here. He remarried and his widow survives, with one daughter, Jennie. Funeral services were held last Saturday from the home of his mother-in-law, Mrs. Ferraro, in Brooklyn, with a sacred blessing at the Church of Our Lady of Pompeii. Interment in the family plot at John's Cemetery.
