

William B. Park, 40 years of age, son of the late Theodore Park, died at his home on Valentine street last Monday morning. He had been for a year or two a sufferer from stomach trouble, but the conditions only became acute two or three days before his death. He had been running the pool room in Rice's Block for a year or two, and closed up the place himself Thursday night before his death. Since his separation from his wife he has lived alone in his Valentine street house. A suit for divorce was pending, and this domestic condition will complicate his affairs. Mrs. Park, from whom he has been separated, is living in Newark, as is their only son.
