

MRS. ROBERT PEACE

HACKETTSTOWN — Funeral services for Mrs. Eleanor J. Peace, 46, of 528 Grand Ave., Hackettstown, were held Monday afternoon at the Gethsemane Lutheran Church, Hackettstown.

Mrs. Peace was found dead Friday night in her auto in a wooded area off Church Road in Dover Township, near Toms River, Ocean County. She had been missing since Sept. 20 when she left the home of her mother, Mrs. Heini Hess 1½ miles away from where she was found. Police said a hose was found running from the exhaust pipe into the interior of the car. Her dog was found dead on the back seat.

Mrs. Peace reportedly was despondent over the death of her husband, Robert Peace, who died last November. An autopsy

revealed death was due to carbon monoxide poisoning.

Mrs. Peace was born March 18, 1918, in Camden. Her father is Floyd Collins of Mount Holly.

She was employed as an assembly worker in the Pyronics Manufacturing Co., Hackettstown. She lived in Hackettstown seven years.

She was a member of Gethsemane Lutheran Church and its Women's Guild.

Survivors include a daughter, Barbara, at home; a brother, Warren Collins, Beverly, and a sister, Mrs. Edna DePallier, Rahway.

Interment was in Hackettstown Union Cemetery.
