

# **CHARLES PHILLIPS HACKETTSTOWN**

Funeral services will be held today for Charles Phillips of 62 Lawrence Drive, who died Monday at Hackettstown Community Hospital, where he had been a patient for a week.

Rites will be conducted at 9:30 a.m. at Cochran Funeral Home by the Rev. Stephen Bielen of St. Mary's Church of the Assumption. Interment will be in Pequest Cemetery, Great Meadows.

Born May 2, 1917 in Elizabeth, Phillips was a son of the late Milton and Rose Wood Phillips. He moved here 13 years ago from Wharton and was a self-employed automobile mechanic.
