Frank Pickel, Former Mayor Of Hackettstown

Frank Pickel, 82, former mayor of Hackettstown, died Friday night at his home, 602 E. Valley View Ave., Hackettstown.

A life-long resident of Hackettstown, he served as mayor from 1933 to 1936 and from 1948 to 1950.

Mr. Pickel was a building contractor and a former building inspector in Hackettstown, retiring five years ago. He was a member of St. James Episcopal Church, Hackettstown, and served as church treasurer 45 years. He was a past master of Independence Lodge 42, F&AM, Hackettstown.

Born July 2, 1885, he was a son of Mr. and Mrs. George Pickel.

His wife, the former Grace Hufnagel, died in 1960.

Surviving are a stepdaughter, Mrs. Russell P. Vliet, of Hackettstown and Florida; three grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

The funeral will be held at 10 a.m. tomorrow in St. James Episcopal Church. Masonic services will be held at 8 o'clock tonight in the Cochran Funeral Home, Hackettstown.
