Patrick Pisaniello, 85, of Independence Township, died July 17, 2008 at the Holy Manor Center in Mendham after a long illness.

Born March 18, 1923 in Brooklyn, he was a son of the late Salvatore and Rose Gallo Pisaniello.

Mr. Pisaniello lived in Flushing, Queens, before moving to New Jersey in 1980 and Independence Township in 1994. He was a communication engineer with AT&T in Morristown for 50 years, retiring in 1984. He received a degree in engineering communications from Cornell University.

An Army veteran of World War II, Mr. Pisaniello participated in the Battle of the

Bulge. He was a member of St. Mary's Church of the Assumption in Hackettstown.

Surviving are his wife, Anna Maria Piacentini Pisaniello; a son, Joseph Piacentini of Hollidaysburg, Pa.; two daughters, Paulette Coyle of Amityville, N.Y., and Patricia Bullock of Burlington, N.C.; a sister, Frances Pelligrino of Mendham; and four grandchildren.

A funeral Mass was held July 21 at St. Mary's Church of the Assumption with Father David Pekola officiating. Interment was in Clover Leaf Memorial Park, Woodbridge.
