

ELLSWORTH A. PITTENGER, 54, a former compositor at The Gazette, died after a long illness at Hackettstown Memorial Hospital on Wednesday, January 15, 1958. He resided here about 15 years, his home was at 153 East Prospect Street. Born in Ringoes on October 19, 1893, he was a son of the late Jonas A. and Mary Cherritt Pittenger. He started at the Hackettstown County Democrat, Flemington, and was employed in Jersey City before coming to The Gazette 15 years ago. He worked later at the Star in Washington and more recently at the Morristown Daily Record.

Survivors are his wife, the former Eleanor Hausman; two sisters, Mrs. Harriett Fulper of Rocktown and Mrs. Sadie McLaughlin of Trenton. A niece, Mrs. Gloria Armstrong, lives at 115 West Plane Street, Hackettstown.

Mr. Pittenger was a member of the Presbyterian Memorial Church, Ringoes.

Funeral arrangements are for the services to be held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Cochran Funeral Home with the Rev. August J. Kling of the First Presbyterian in charge. Interment will be in Rosemont Cemetery, Rosemont.
