

Attack Is Fatal To Mrs. Leo Place

Mrs. Ethel Place, of Meshoppen, wife of Leo Place, died unexpectedly Sunday afternoon, November 21, 1965, at her home.

Born in South Auburn, Susquehanna County, Mrs. Place was a daughter of the late John and Harriet Luce Barnmatyne, and lived most of her life in Meshoppen and vicinity. She was a graduate of the Meshoppen High School and Stroudsburg State Normal School, now East Stroudsburg State College, and for several terms taught in the school districts of Wyoming and Susquehanna Counties.

Mrs. Place was a member of the Meshoppen Methodist Church and Meshoppen Chapter, Order of Eastern Star. She and her husband had celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary several years ago.

Surviving, besides her husband, are a daughter, Mrs. Samuel Mazzotta, of Wildwood Crest, N. J.; two sons, Arthur, of Tunkhannock, and John, of Clarks Summit; one sister, Mrs. Clarence Treible, of Tunkhannock; two brothers, Rodney Barnmatyne, of Bridgeport, Conn., and Randall Barnmatyne, of Pittsburgh; eight grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren.

The funeral was held Wednesday afternoon at the Sheldon Funeral Home, in Meshoppen, with the Rev. Daniel Davis, pastor of the Meshoppen Methodist Church, officiating. Burial was in Overfield Cemetery.
