

Eloise Poe, chiropractic doctor

Eloise Poe, 93, of the House of Good Shepherd, Hackettstown, died Sunday, April 27, in Hackettstown Community Hospital.

She was a homemaker.

Born Jan. 6, 1904, in Oakdale, Long Island, N.Y., she was a daughter of the late Thomas and Martha Bassett Hawkins. She lived in the House of Good Shepherd for the past three months. Prior to that she lived in Heath Village in Hackettstown for the last 10 years, coming from Hampton. Before that she lived in Califon for 57 years.

She was a 50-year member of Califon United Methodist Church, where she was a former director of the Church Youth Group, past president of the W.S.C.S., and was a member of the Administrative Council and the Pastor-Parish Relations Committee, all of the church.

She was a graduate of the Carver Chiropractic Institute of New York City, and was a licensed doctor of chiropractic medicine.

She was a former auxiliary member of the New Jersey and National Chiropractic Association. She was a member of Hobart Chapter 63, Order of Eastern Star in High Bridge. She was also active in several local civic organizations.

Her husband, Dr. George F., died in 1982.

She is survived by two daughters, Eloise Marlatt-Mial of Blairstown and Dolly Cox of Tewksbury Township; six grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren.

Memorial services will be held at 4 p.m. Sunday in the Califon United Methodist Church, 15 River Road, Califon. There will be no calling hours.

Burial will be private in Musconetcong Valley Cemetery in Hampton.
