Helen Barbara Polgar, 64, of Sun Prairie, Wis., died Aug. 11, at home, after a long battle with lupus and congestive heart failure.

Born Nov. 21, 1936 in New Brunswick, she was a daughter of the late Gilbert and Helen (Kedves) Papp. In 1965 she married Emerick T. Polgar in Boston, Mass.

She lived in Ocean Springs, Miss., from 1970 to 1981, where she taught briefly at Notre Dame High School in Biloxi. She was active in her community as a member of the Friends of the Library, the PTA, and also served on the political campaigns of Bill Dale and Trent Lott.

In 1981 she moved to Hackettstown, where she spent several years as a special education teacher and worked for the War-

ren County Board of Elections. She retired to Sun Prairie in 1996.

In addition to her husband, she is survived by her three children, Emerick M. of Bradenton, Fla., Rebecca of Baltimore, Md., and Elizabeth of Sun Prairie, Wis.; a sister, Lydia Leik of York, Pa.; a granddaughter, Camille Polgar; and several nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her brother, Gilbert.
