

Funeral held for Mr. Pollock

HACKETTSTOWN —

Funeral services were held at 10 a.m. yesterday for George F. Pollock, 73, of Mount Rascal Road, who died Sunday at Hackettstown Community Hospital after a short illness.

Born June 9, 1904 in Trenton, he was a son of the late Charles E. and Katherine Meagher Pollock. He moved here in 1947.

Mr. Pollock retired in 1972 after 50 years as a highway inspector for the state. He was a member of Sts. Peter and Paul Roman Catholic Church, Great Meadows.

He is survived by three sons, George W. and Robert, both of Hackettstown, and John C. of Concord, N.H.; two brothers, Robert of Demarest and Charles E. of Pennington, and four grandchildren.
