Antoinette M. Pool

Antoinette M. Pool, 78, of Hackettstown, died on Dec. 10 at Hackettstown Community Hospital.

Born in Succasunna, she had lived in Hackettstown all of her adult life, coming from the Roxbury and Ledgewood area.

She was employed by Centenary College in Hackettstown as a secretary to the librarian, retiring in 1983.

She was of the Roman Catholic faith, was a volunteer at the Hackettstown Community Hospital, a member of the Hackettstown Historical Society, a former member of the Hackettstown Parent Teachers Association, and board of education. She also served in the U.S. Navy as a "WAVE," a woman's naval designation, during World War II.

She is survived by two sons, Dick Pool, of Independence Township, and William Pool, of Otega, N.Y.; one brother, Louis Nero, of Succasunna; and one sister, Madelyn Gallo, of Atlantic City. Her husband, Richard W. Pool, died in 1991.

Burial was in the Union Cemetery in Hackettstown and arrangements were made by the Cochran Funeral Home of Hackettstown.
