CHARLOTTE, N.C. ô Wallace W. Poole, a long-time resident of Hunterdon and Warren counties, passed away February 22, 2012.

Born Oct. 24, 1919 in High Bridge to Minnie S. & David C. Poole, he attended High Bridge Public Schools, and was in the Class of 1937.

Mr. Poole was married to Eleanor (nee Caviezel) of Easton, Pa. for 65 years; she passed away in June 2011. She had been a cafeteria manager at High Bridge High School.

He served in the Army from 1941 to 1945, stationed in North Africa and the Middle East. He then joined the New Jersey State Police, and eventually became a commander of various local stations. He was involved with the Safety Patrol and was assigned to the Skillman Institute.
