ANDOVER — Funeral services were held Tuesday for a Newton couple killed Friday in an automobile accident.

Everett H. Powers, 60, and his wife, Evelyn J., 39, lived at 40 Mountain View Terr., Newton, and formerly lived in Hackettstown. They were killed in an accident on Route 206.

Powers was an Army veteran of World War II and a member of the Lt. Charles A. Meyer Post 86, American Legion; Disable American Veterans; Hackettstown Elks Lodge 233 and the Newton Moose Lodge 432.

The couple is survived by eight children, John, 18; Samuel, 17; David, 14; William, 10; Cheryl, 16; Tina,

15, LouAnne, 11, and Brenda, 8.
