EDWARD E. PROTZMAN.

Edward E. Protzman of this place, died suddenly on Sunday evening last at about 7 o'clock, aged 58 years, 7 months and 22 days. He had been failing in health for several months, and had been confined to his bed for a week previous to his demise. On Sunday evening he expressed a desire for some oyster broth and had just partaken thereof, when death came upon him.

The deceased was born in Maryland, on September 19, 1825 and came to Hacketts-town, thirty-one years ago, during which time he has followed his trade, of a tinsmith. He was at the time of his decease, Noble Grand of Musconetcong Lodge, No. 81, I. O. O. F. and was respected by his fellow citizens generally.

The services took place in the M. E. church on Wednesday afternoon, at 2:30, the Rev. J. A. Monroe preaching from the text 2d Corinthians, V. chapter, 1st verse. He was buried by his brethern in Odd Fellowship, with the proper burial ceremonies of their order.
