HACKETTSTOWN — Raymond C. Skinner, 95, died Tuesday, Aug. 26 at Hackettstown Community Hospital, Hackettstown.

Born March 19, 1908 in Wilson, NC, he was the son of the late John and Gertrude (Heath) Skinner and the husband of the late Ethel Marie (Hansen) Skinner (1997).
