### Kathryn Slingerland

HACKETTSTOWN — Kathryn Slingerland, 52, died Wednesday, Feb. 25, 2004, in her mother's home, after showing unbelievable courage fighting a long illness.

Born on Dec. 15, 1951, in Brooklyn, N.Y., she was a daughter of Patricia Pankanin Schultz of Hackettstown and the late Edward Schultz.

She had moved to Hackettstown in 1963 from Brooklyn, attended Holy Family School and St. Mary's in Hackettstown, and graduated from Hackettstown High School, class of 1969. Kathryn worked for the House of Good Shepherd in Hackettstown and later for Foster Wheeler in Livingston.

She is survived by her husband, John; her mother, Patricia of Hackettstown; a son, Kenneth at home; a daughter, Kara Slingerland at home; a brother, Kenneth Schultz of Hackettstown; her maternal grandmother, Theresa Pankanin of Hackettstown; and her aunt and godmother, Ceil Olivieri of Hackettstown.

Her father, Edward Schultz, past Grand Knight Joyce Kilmer Council Post 2483 in Hackettstown, died earlier.

A Mass was held in the church. Arrangements were by the Scala Memorial Home, Hackettstown. Burial was in Pequest Union Cemetery, Great Meadows.
