

THOMAS S. SMALE

Thomas S. Smale, 88 years old, died Wednesday of last week at his home, 102 B street, Pen Argyl, Pa. He was a native of Cornwall, England, son of the late John and Margaret Smith Smale, and had resided in this country since childhood. He lived in Pen Argyl for the last 50 years. He was an active member of Zion Methodist Church, Pen Argyl.

Mr. Smale was an authority on slate and was well known thruout the Pennsylvania area. He took prizes at the exposition at St. Louis.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Mary J. Smale; six children, Thomas S. Smale Jr., of Hackettstown, whom he has visited a number of times; John G.
