Mrs. Eliza J. Smith

At the advanced age of eighty-four years Mrs. Eliza Jane Smith died Monday at her home, 328 Hawthorne Avenue, East Orange. She was the widow of John McCracken Smith; who died seventeen years ago at his East Orange home. Mr. and Mrs. Smith were former residents of Hackettstown, residing on Willow Grove Street in the house now occupied by Elston Read and family. Mr. Smith being associated in the carriage manufacturing business, at that time one of the leading local industries. Mrs. Smith was a native of the vicinity of Newark, and death came to her at the close of a well spent life devoted to home, family and the community of which she was an interested resident.
