

Frank Smith Expires; Supervisor Of Roads

Funeral rites for Frank H. Smith were held Sunday afternoon at the Pichi Funeral Home, Stanhope, and interment followed in the Union Cemetery, Hackettstown. The Rev. Thomas Skyler of Mt. Olive Presbyterian Church was in charge of the services.

Mr. Smith, road supervisor of Mt. Olive Township, died on Friday, November 14, 1952, from a heart attack at his home on Route 6, Budd Lake.

Born in Hackettstown 66 years ago, Mr. Smith before becoming supervisor at Mt. Olive seven years ago was engaged in the road contracting business for 25 years in Hackettstown. He was a member of Newton Lodge of Elks.
