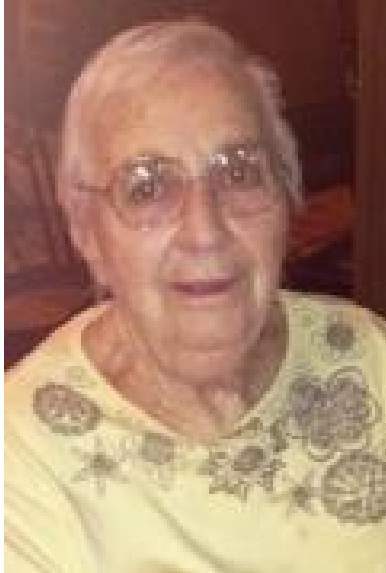


OBITUARY
