### Katherine Miller Snyder

Katherine Miller Snyder, 95, of the House of Good Shepherd in Hackettstown, died Sept. 5, after a long illness.

Born Aug. 22, 1904, in Newark, she was a daughter of the late John and Elizabeth Nowak Kowalski.

She resided in Newark, Irvington and in Toms River from 1969 to 1993, coming to Hackettstown in 1993.
