

Frank Souders, Ex-Hackettstown Principal, Dies

HACKETTSTOWN — Frank A. Souders, 84, of 226 Main St., Hackettstown, a former principal of Hackettstown High School, died Monday at Warren Haven.

He was born in Phillipsburg and came to Hackettstown in 1907. Souders was a graduate of Phillipsburg High School in 1903 and Lafayette College in 1907. He taught at Hackettstown High School from 1907 to 1919 and served as principal from 1919 to 1941.

He was a member of Independence Lodge 42 F&AM, a member of Trinity United Methodist Church, Hackettstown and a charter member of Hackettstown Kiwanis Club.

His only immediate survivor is a daughter, Mrs. Beatrice Searfoss of Hackettstown, three grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

Services will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday from the Cochran Funeral Home, Hackettstown. A Masonic service will be held there at 8 p.m. tonight.
