MISS IDA B. STEPHENS

Funeral services were held yesterday afternoon at the Cochran Funeral Home for Miss Ida B. Stephens, 81, who died Sunday night, October 22, 1944, at her home on Washington Street. She was a native of Kansas, daughter of the late Preston and Charlotte Stephens and spent most of her life in Hackettstown.

She was an active church worker, being a member of the First Presbyterian Church and of the Woman's Missionary Society of that church. A graduate of Hackettstown Centenary Collegiate Institute and Vassar College, she was secretary for a number of years of the New Jersey State Young People's Society.

Miss Stephens is survived by a brother, W. Ernest Stephens of Washington Street.

The Rev. C. Gordon Reynolds of First Presbyterian Church, conducted the funeral services and burial was in Hackettstown Union Cemetery.
