

CHARLES TIMBRELL HACKETTSTOWN —

Funerals services were held Tuesday for Charles H. Timbrell, 86, of 506 First Ave., who died Saturday at Hackettstown Community Hospital after a long illness.

Born Oct. 16, 1889 in Stanhope, he was a son of the late Heman A. and Ida Stone Timbrell.

A member of Musconetcong Lodge 151 F&AM, Budd Lake, he was the oldest living past master of that lodge. He was also the oldest past grand organist of the state masonic lodge.

He served as organist at the Stanhope Methodist Church from 1904 to 1924 and organist at the First Presbyterian Church, Hackettstown, from 1924 until his retirement in 1961. He was an elder of the church.

He is survived by his widow, the former Alma Wilkenson; a son, Dr. Charles W. Timbrell of Hackettstown; a daughter, Mrs. Clare Swanson of Neshanic; five grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

Services were at the Cochran Funeral Home, 905 High St., Hackettstown, with Masonic services Monday night.
