

Mrs. Elizabeth McLean Tims, widow of John Tims, died quite suddenly at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Lewis C. Heed, on Grand avenue, Wednesday evening. She had been making her home with her daughter, and had been spending a short time with her sister, Mrs. J. N. Lanaberry, in Vienna, returning on Tuesday. A chronic weakness of the heart developed, and she passed away before her children could reach the sick room. Mrs. Tims was 78 years of age. Her life had been largely spent in Hackettstown, and she had endeared herself to a very large circle of friends. Five children survive: Mrs. L. T. Burrows, of Brooklyn; Mrs. M. T. Bryant, of Chicago; Mrs. A. C. Gilson, of Fall River; Mrs. L. C. Heed, of Hackettstown, and John Tims, of St. Louis. Rev.
