

OBITUARY.

JOHN B. TITUS.

John B. Titus, Esq., one of the oldest of our citizens, died on Wednesday morning, aged 84 years and 7 days. Mr. Titus was a life-long resident of the place, and held many positions of trust and honor in the community. He was the first mayor after the incorporation of the town, and was justice of the peace two terms. Of late years he has been quite feeble and badly crippled by rheumatism, at times suffering terribly. In politics he was an "old line" Democrat. His death was not unexpected. Mr. Titus leaves a second wife, sister of the first, and two children, Mr. John Titus and Mrs. Burt, the survivors out of a family of 12. The funeral will take place from his late residence, at eleven o'clock to-morrow (Saturday) morning.
