Interment rites were conducted at the Hackettstown Union Cemetery on Monday for Charles Toepfer, 69, who died on Friday, May 5, 1944, at his home, 402 Orange Street, Newark, after an illness of several weeks. The funeral was held Sunday night at the Cole funeral home, Newark.

A native of Hackettstown, Mr. Toepfer was a son of the late John and Sarah Barker Toepfer. He leaves his wife, Mrs. Nettle Carpenter Toepfer; a sister, Mrs. Verna T. McCracken of Caldwell; and two brothers, William of Hackettstown, and Theodore of Washington.

Mr. Toepfer in recent years had served as a conductor on passenger trains between Hoboken and Washington. He was a member of the Lackawanna Railroad Veterans' Association.
