## Allan Tomlinson, 84, ex-schools chief in Warren

WASHINGTON TWP. - Allan Tomlinson, Warren County Superintendent of Schools from 1956-75, died Wednesday at Heath Village in Washington Township. He was 84.

Born in Doylestown, Pa., he lived in Belvidere for 33 years before moving to Heath Village seven years

ago.

Before working as Warren County superintendent of schools, Mr. Tomlinson was superintendent of schools in Penns Grove from 1948-56. Prior to that, he taught chemistry and physics in Bucks County, Pa., was a science teacher in Rancocas and a vice principal at Fair Lawn High School.

He was a 1935 graduate of Shippensburg University in Pennsyl-

vania.

He was a former member of the United Presbyterian Church in Belvidere. He was an elder of the Belvidere United Presbyterian Church until 1989 and was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Hackettstown.

Mr. Tomlinson was president of the Belvidere Building and Loan As-

sociation for many years.

He was a member of the Warren Hospital Board of Directors for 20 years, the Warren County Vocational School Board, the Free Public Library Commission of Warren County and the Board of Directors of the Visiting Nurses Association of Warren County.

His wife, Edna (Lang), died in

1990.

Survivors include a son, A. Scott of Hackettstown; a daughter, Bonnie Wilson of Mount Pleasant, Pa.; a brother, Howard of Vincentown; a sister, Elizabeth Rowe of Camp Hill, Pa.; four grandchildren; and one great-granddaughter.

Allan Tomlinson, 84, of Heath Village, Washington Township (Morris), died on March 12 at Heath Village.

He was born in Dovlestown. Pa., and lived at Heath Village for seven years coming from Belvidere, where he lived for 33 years.

Mr. Tomlinson was the son of the late William S. and Mabel Houck Tomlinson.

He was the husband of the late Edna Lang Tomlinson, who died in 1990.

Mr. Tomlinson was employed as Warren County Superintendent of Schools from 1956 through 1975, prior to which he was Superintendent of Schools in Penns Grove, Pa., from 1948 through 1956.

He was graduated from Shippensburg University in 1935. He was a former member of United Presbyterian Church Belvidere, president of the Belvidere Building and Loan Association for many years, and elder of Belvidere United Presbyterian Church until 1989.
