

Robert Topoleski: Accident Victim

LIBERTY TWP. — Robert M. Topoleski Jr., 18, Route 46, Great Meadows, died yesterday in Hackettstown Community Hospital from injuries sustained in an automobile accident early yesterday morning.

He was killed when the car in which he was a passenger struck a utility pole in Great Meadows on Route 46, police said. Two other 18-year-old men were injured and hospitalized, according to police.

The driver, Lars Rolfsen, Great Meadows, was admitted to Hackettstown Hospital with head and arm injuries. Another passenger, Kevin Studley, Vienna, was admitted with head and leg injuries.

Police said the car went out of control at about 3:15 a.m. and its right side struck the pole. Topoleski was pronounced dead at the scene. Police are continuing their investigation.

Born in Newton, Mr. Topoleski had lived all his life in this area. He worked as a carpenter for Gary Miller Mason Contractors, Rahway.

He is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Robert M. Topoleski Sr., Great Meadows; a brother, John, at home; and two sisters, Patricia and Teresa, both at home.

Services will be held 9 a.m. tomorrow from the Cochran Funeral Home, Hackettstown, to St. Peter and Paul Church, Great Meadows, where a Mass of Christian Burial will be offered at 9:30 a.m.
