HACKETTSTOWN — Wesley H. Trippett died Saturday at his home. He was 92.

He was born in Montclair and lived in Montana, Arizona, Verona and Livingston before moving to Hackettstown two years ago.

In 1915 he graduated from the University of Montana with a bachelor's degree in forestry.

Mr. Trippett was a surveyor for Miller and McGiffert Civil Engineers in Montclair for 45 years before retiring in 1963. He had also worked as an Arizona ranger.

He was a member of the Montclair Kiwanis Club and the Old Guard of Livingston.

During World War I, he served in the U.S. Navy.
