

List Services for Paul A. Valentine

Paul A. Valentine, age 89, of Auburndale, Fla., formerly of Laceyville and Mehoopany, died Monday, January 4, 1965, at home after an illness.

Born in Washington Township, a son of the late John B. and Mary E. Jennings Valentine, he formerly lived in Trucksville, where he was one of the earliest rural delivery mail carriers in Luzerne County. He also operated a blacksmith's shop in Trucksville for several years. Mr. Valentine was active in the Dairymen's League and was president of the Wyoming County branch of this group during the early 1920's.

In 1940, he was ordained a lay pastor of the Southern Methodist Conference and served at churches at Buena Vista, Tribby and Laceyville, all in Florida. In 1958 he retired from the Methodist ministry.

He had lived in Laceyville, Mehoopany, and Tunkhannock at various times. He was an active member of the Pennsylvania Grange for several years.

Surviving are his wife, the former Mary Pickett; a daughter, Mrs. Edith Tiffany, of St. Petersburg, Fla.; two sons, A. P. Valentine, of Laceyville, and K. E. Valentine, of Wheaton, Md.; a half-sister, Mrs. Florence Weidner, of Brooklyn, N. Y.; nine grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren.

The funeral will be held at Buena Vista Thursday afternoon, with additional services at the Sheldon Funeral Home in Meshoppen on Saturday at 1:00 P. M. The Rev. Richard Gregory, pastor of the Braintrim Baptist Church of Laceyville, will officiate. Friends may call Friday evening from 7 to 9.
