MRS. WELSH KILLED.

Railroad Crossing Accident Near

Miami, Fla., While Autoing.

No sadder word could have been

received here than that of yesterday afternoon announcing that Mrs. M. T. Welsh of Grand avenue met death yesterday near Miami, Fla., when an auto in which she and companions were riding was struck by a train at a grade crossing and that her body was being held at a morgue in Miami awaiting orders of relatives. The report was to the effect that Mr. Welsh is in a hospital, but not critically injured. Mr. and Mrs. E. R. Armstrong of Easton, Pa., with whom Mr. and Mrs. Welsh went South ten days ago, also were in the accident. Mr. Armstrong is dead. At the time the Gazette went to press last night no further details of the accident were available.
