

## C. E. Westbrooke

Funeral services were held Thursday for Charles E. Westbrooke, 93, of Hope who died March 2 in Barn Hill Convalescent Center in Newton.

Mr. Westbrooke was born in Hope and resided in the area all his life.

Mr. Westbrooke was an employee of the People's National Bank of Hackettstown, now the United Jersey Bank, and a director there from 1947 to 1963. He was also a cashier at the National Bank of Hope.

When he was a young man he had operated a meat market in Hope for 15 years.

He was executor of many estates, public sales clerk and a clerk in the Hackettstown auction market for 30 years.

He was Hope tax assessor and secretary of the Hope Board of Health for 37 years.

Mr. Westbrooke served as the grand marshal of the Hope Bicentennial.

He was a trustee and secretary of the Hope Cemetery Association for 20 years and a trustee of Johnsonburg Christian Cemetery Association of which he was still serving.

He was a member and trustee of St. John's United Methodist Church in Hope.

He was a 50-year member of Blairstown Lodge 165, F&AM.

Mr. Westbrooke is survived by cousins.

Interment was in Hope Cemetery. Arrangements were by the MacFadden Funeral Home, Belvidere.
