

## OBITUARY

### STEWART DEAN WILLIAMS, JR.

Private services were held Monday afternoon at the grave in Hackettstown Union Cemetery for Stewart Dean Williams, infant son of Mr. and Mrs. Stewart D. Williams of Main Street, who died suddenly on Friday afternoon, July 6, 1945. The Rev. Sydney E. Grant, vicar of St. James' Episcopal Church, conducted the rites.

Born February 22, 1945, the child appeared to be in perfect health when he was put out for an afternoon nap at the rear of the store operated by his father. Shortly after 4 o'clock he was found dead by Mrs. Williams, who was assisting in the store and making periodic check-ups on the infant. Dr. Walter H. Harmon, who was summoned immediately, pronounced the child dead. The fatal trouble was diagnosed by Dr. Herman Baldauf, county physician, as an enlarged thymus gland.
