

# John D. Woodward, Leather Treasurer

Funeral services for John D. Woodward of 209 Church Street, treasurer of the Lackawanna Leather Company for more than 25 years, were conducted Tuesday afternoon at the Cochran Funeral Home by the Rev. Frank T. Reed of Trinity Methodist Church. Interment followed in Evergreen Cemetery, Elizabeth.

A resident of Hackettstown since 1905, Mr. Woodward died on Friday, December 9, 1955, at his home after a brief illness. He was born 77 years ago in Elizabeth, a son of the late Isaac and Rachel Haycock Woodward. In addition to being treasurer, Mr. Woodward served as Lackawanna's accountant.
