

Princie A. Young, college teacher

HACKETTSTOWN — Princie A. Young, 89, of House of the Good Shepherd, died Sunday, April 2, in Hackettstown Community Hospital.

She was a teacher in the business department of Centenary College from 1959 until retiring in 1970. Before that, she taught in Montfort College in Montfort, N.C.
