

## John E. Zhelesnik

John E. Zhelesnik, 81, of 33 Petersburg Road in Hackettstown, died Wednesday in his home after a long illness.

He was a machinist for New Jersey Tool and Die in Roselle Park, N.J., for 15 years before retiring in 1969. He also served in the Army.

Born October 21, 1907, in Kistpest, Hungary, he was a son of the late Lewis and Flora Kalamcu Zhelesnik. He resided most of his life in Elizabeth, N.J., and for the past 10 years in Hackettstown.
